The Lake Jindabyne Hotel has a large restaurant for your evening meals, plus 2 bars and plenty of spots you can sit down and enjoy a drink and the lakefront views.

It is central in town and an easy stroll to the supermarket, cafes, chemist, newsagency, post office and all other facilities you may need.

The tour is inclusive of all meals and entry fees, on day one however lunch is at your own expense while travelling to Jindabyne.

We leave the hotel daily between 8.00am and 9.00am. We employ local guides who are passionate about the history and the area they live in.

We try to fit as much into the tour while maintaining a relaxed pace. (Note: the tour is subject to change without notice due to the alpine weather and road conditions).

Day One

Sydney to Jindabyne.

Travelling in a 5 star seat belt equipped modern coach you are sure to be safe and comfortable.

Day Two

We head to Jindabyne's Visitor Centre for a short film and an opportunity to explore the centre.

Then off to the Wildbrumby Distillery for schnapps and gin tasting or wander through their extensive sculpture gardens.

Next is Dead Horse Gap and Thredbo Village to enjoy lunch beside the Thredbo River. You then have the option of a chair lift ride or a stroll around the alpine village.

Heading back you drive to Bullocks Flat for a look at the one and only Skitube Alpine Railway of Australia.

Day Three

Today is your half day, we head to Gaden Trout Hatchery for a guided tour. Then a scenic drive through the mountains looking at Smiggins and Perisher ski resorts and also Charlotte Pass. From the lookout you will view Australia's highest peak, Mount Kosciuszko. We head back to the hotel for a BBQ lunch on the deck. The afternoon is your time to explore Jindabyne.

Day Four

We start our day at Cooma Gaol dating from 1870, a functioning correctional facility. You will receive a tour of the living museum by suitable inmates.

We then travel to the village of Berridale for a tour of historical sites including Gedgezerick Church and the Berridale Historical society. The day continues with a trip to Dalgety, the only town remaining along the banks of the Snowy River. You travel onward through farming country back to Jindabyne.

Day Five

We begin with a visit to the Snowy Hydro Discovery Centre at Cooma, where a tour of the facility explores the past, present and future of the mighty Snowy Scheme.

After morning tea and a drive through the Monaro plains to Adaminaby we tour the Snowy Scheme Museum which celebrates the people who created one of the seven engineering wonders of the world.

On our way back the coach stops to take in the mighty Eucumbene Dam before heading to the motel for your final nights stay.
