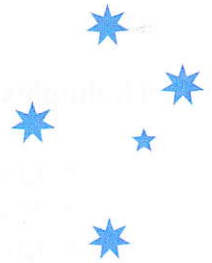

While focusing on Orange, our tour will explore much of the Central West, showcasing Oberon and Bathurst. Oberon is a small but thriving community and the highest town in the Blue Mountains/Central Tableland region with an elevation of 1113 metres above sea level. Bathurst, as our oldest settlement west of the ranges, is rich in history and is a vibrant regional city.

Orange – Australia's colour city offers a diverse range of wonderful attractions and four very different seasons ensure your visit will be a little different each time, with each season having its own special charm. Canobolas, an extinct volcano, towers over Orange and the Cabonne country surveying its legacy of fertility. The area has a fine reputation as a food bowl with grain fed beef, fat lambs, grapes, apples, cherries, stone fruit, berries, nuts and vegetables all produced in abundance.



Orange today is a sophisticated and prosperous city with a history dating back to the very first gold rush and many fine heritage buildings. It is also the perfect base to explore the many fascinating towns like Cowra, Canowindra, Carcoar, Ophir and Millthorpe which all make Orange such a great destination.
