

80TH ANNIVERSARY CRUISE

SYDNEY UNDER JAPANESE SUBMARINE ATTACK

2 CRUISE DATES 31 MAY AND 1 JUNE 2022

The 1942 Japanese midget submarine attack on ships in Sydney Harbour remains a topical subject. However, many Sydneysiders know little about this watershed event.

This cruise will provide a detailed description of events leading up to and during the attack.

The story will be told by expert narrators from the Naval Historical Society supported by a complimentary booklet of photos to bring the story to life. The cruise will take you to sites on the Harbour where key events occurred and how those events unfolded on the fateful night of 31 May/1 June 1942.

Morning tea and snacks are available on-board.

Probus has secured 10 seats on both the 31 May and the 1 June cruises (20 in total). These are the remaining seats available and both cruises have sold out. The Society is considering a further tour if they achieve the viable number.
