

SEVEN ISLANDS OF THE HAWKESBURY

This 3 hour cruise will depart at 10.15am from the Brooklyn public wharf

On Monday the 20th of February 2023.

Learn the history of the islands of the Hawkesbury River on the most popular cruise offered by Hawkesbury Cruises.

You will learn the history of Lion, Dangar, Spectacle, Long, Peat, Milson and Bar Islands. Cruise past the water-access-only settlements of the lower Hawkesbury and see the wreck of the HMAS Parramatta, Australia's first warship and find out how it ended up lying at the bottom of a cliff.

The views to the ocean behind Lion Island make for some spectacular photos, as will the close-up view of some ancient Aboriginal rock carvings at Eagle Rock, near Broken Bay.

The cruise includes morning tea and lunch. Water is provided and drinks (soft and hard) can be purchased at the bar.

Car parking is available at Brooklyn for members that do not wish to journey by rail. It is recommended that you arrive early as sometimes finding spaces can be difficult. For members travelling by rail, there is a lift service from the platforms to the street level.
